

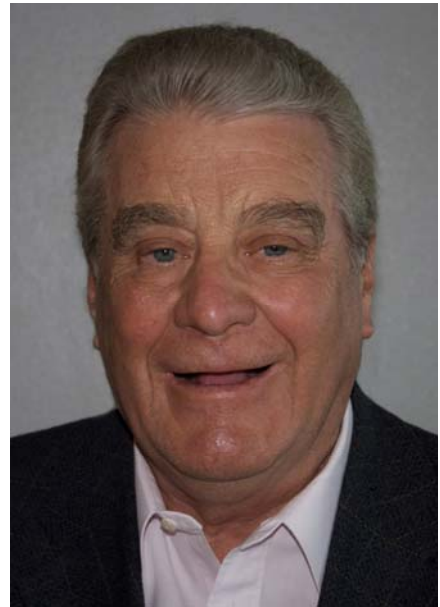
## Featured Physician

Dr. Rodiles received his medical degree from the University of Buenos Aires, Argentina, and completed an internal medicine residency with Air Force Central Hospital, Buenos Aires. He completed an internship with Mercy Hospital in Chicago, Illinois, and a second internal medicine residency at the Veterans Administration Hospital, Long Beach, California. He also completed a nephrology fellowship there.

Dr. Rodiles is board certified in both internal medicine and nephrology. He has authored or coauthored numerous medical publications. He has served as chief of staff at PMH.
